- 0 Each player's point quota goal is based upon the above chart. Points are awarded from gross scores only, and the field has been divided into flights based upon handicaps and the number of players. *There are no negative points for a double bogey or higher; therefore, players may 'pick up' their ball if their score reaches double bogey or higher.* In addition, there is no bonus point or penalty for making or not making a player's quota. Players in each flight with the most points above their quota goal (or closest to their quota) are the winners within their flight. Example: Player Bob Parr. Handicap 8. Quota 31. Points Awarded 33. Score Plus 2.
- 0 Players will be awarded points as follows: **Double bogey or higher score = zero (0) points; Bogey = 1 point; Par = 2 points; Birdie = 4 points; Eagle or Double Eagle = 8 points.**
- 0 Please exchange scorecards with fellow competitors in your group. Each player's "point quota" has been marked on his scorecard. **Please, only record the player's gross score for each hole.** Recording points for the score on each hole is optional. The golf shop staff is responsible for recording official point scores.
- 0 Cash games (\$8.00) - optional. Closest to the pin (all par 3's), gross skins and net skins.

**USGA RULES WILL GOVERN PLAY WITH THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES**

1. All play will be from the black tee markers.
  - a. Local rules are posted on the men's club bulletin board in the clubhouse.
  - b. The "desert rule" on the scorecard is **not** in effect during men's club tournaments.
  - c. All ponds are "lateral water hazards." **Note:** a "ball drop" zone, which may be used in lieu of options 26-1b and 26-1c of rule 26, has been placed to the west side of hole 12 green.
  - d. "Doubt as to rule / procedure." Play the ball as it lies, and then play a second ball under the rule / procedure the player believes to be correct. Be sure to announce to fellow competitors that you are using the second ball rule.
2. **Slow play.** We must finish men's club competitions in 4 1/4 hours or less. Therefore, the 500 club Staff and Player Assistants have the authority to warn and penalize any group or player for any rule 6-7, undue delay; slow play situation.
